Adapting and implementing harm reduction strategies for primary care patients who use substances

- ▶ What would be most helpful for you and your clinic regarding harm reduction?
 - ▶ Menu of harm reduction options for clinicians and patients
 - ▶ Which substances should be included? (stimulants, opioids, alcohol, cannabis, etc.)
 - ▶ Would you be willing to discuss strategies for safer misuse of prescription drugs?
