

## COVID-19 RISK MITIGATION COMPLIANCE ATTESTATION

The WPRN Coordinating Center and the Institute of Translational Health Sciences are excited to host the in-person WPRN Annual Conference on May 18, 2022. In order to ensure a safe and healthy experience for all conference staff, presenters, and conference attendees, we have developed a COVID-19 Prevention Plan. This plan has been developed in consultation with the WPRN Steering Committee and is in accordance with all University of Washington and local COVID-19 guidance.

For all conference participants planning to attend <u>in-person</u>, please complete and accept the following COVID-19 attestation to participate in the WPRN Annual Conference (May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022) at the University of Washington (UW).

## We ask that all in-person attendees complete this form 24 hours before the conference.

I understand health and safety is a responsibility shared by all visitors at UW. To ensure the health and safety of the UW community, I hereby attest that:

<u>Vaccination</u> – All attendees, vendors and conference staff will be required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Full vaccination is in accordance with CDC guidance (<u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/stay-up-to-</u> <u>date.html?s\_cid=11747:cdc%20up%20to%20date%20vaccine:sem.ga:p:RG:GM:gen:PTN:FY22</u>).

I am fully vaccinated against COVID-19 in accordance with CDC guidance

<u>Stay home if you are sick</u> – All staff and attendees should stay home if they have symptoms of COVID-19, have been exposed to COVID-19 or have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days. Attendees are recommended to follow CDC quarantine and isolation guidance (<u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/quarantine-isolation.html</u>).

I confirm that I have no symptoms of COVID-19

I confirm that I have not tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days

I confirm that I have had no known high-risk exposure to an individual with COVID19 in the past 14 days

<u>Testing</u> – The WPRN Coordinating Center strongly encourages conference attendees to perform a COVID-19 test in the 24 hours prior to the start of the conference and attend the conference in-person only if the result is negative.

<u>Masking</u> – All UW staff, vendors and conference attendees will be required to wear a highquality face mask, covering their nose and mouth, while in the conference space. Signs for masking will be posted. Extra masks will be provided.

I confirm that I understand and will adhere to the masking requirement

The UW will ensure the following additional COVID-19 prevention measures:

<u>Eating</u> - Meals will be provided as boxed lunches. No eating in the conference space is permitted. Attendees and staff will be encouraged to spread out and eat outside, weather permitting, for meals. Signs reminding conference attendees of food and beverage rules will be posted.

<u>Drinking</u> – Conference attendees are permitted to have a covered beverage (water bottle, cup with lid) and remove their masks briefly for drinking.

<u>Cleaning</u> – Frequently cleaning of high touch surfaces is provided by the UW building management.

<u>Hand washing/sanitizing</u> – Hand sanitizing stations are provided by the UW building management. Signs encouraging hand hygiene will be posted.

<u>Ventilation - Ventilation and air quality is monitored by the UW building management.</u>
