

# De-identified Clinical Data Repository – Epic Problem List

Please follow the steps described below to query the Epic Problem List Diagnoses (only those coded as ICD9)



## Searching for Epic Problem list (This is for **BOTH active and resolved problems**):

### 1. By Navigating Terms

Go to “Epic Problem List” folder, browse and find the right criteria


### 2. By Finding Terms

Search for ICD9 codes or search words in “Search by Names” (be sure to select “Epic Problem List” for search category to refine your results!)



### Note:

- Search by term can result in a large number of results (Epic Problems are very granular). We recommend searching by ICD9 code if possible.
- Some of the folders have more than 500 sub-folder items. Please click on the “Show Options” (click green check icon on top left of the navigate window) and change the “Maximum number of children to display” to a higher number



## Only Searching for **Active problems**:

### 3. By Navigating Terms

Under each level of folder in Epic Problem List, you will see “Active Problem List” option (with blue circular icon). Drag it into the query window to query only the active problems.

### 4. By Finding Terms

- Right click on the result of the Find Terms that you’d limit to only active problems.
  - Click “Find Modifiers”
  - Find Modifiers menu will pop up below
  - Click “Get All” and you will get list of options available to search.
- Drag “Active Problem List” option to the query tool to only search only for active problem list.
