




The 3 <u>Essential</u> Conditions of Team Effectiveness




The 3 Enabling Conditions of Team Effectiveness




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The 3 Enablers

FOR 6 CONDITIONS

	HOW IS MY TEAM'S DESIGN? A B C D F	HOW MIGHT WE IMPROVE OUR DESIGN?
REAL TEAM GRADE OVERALL	Everyone knows exactly who is/not on the team; we are well bounded Membership stays the same for significant periods of time; the team is stable The team is interdependent for a common purpose; we need to work closely together to accomplish it	
COMPELLING PURPOSE GRADE OVERALL	Our team purposes are clear: everyone knows what success would look like The team's purpose is genuinely consequential for the lives and work of others The team purpose is challenging but attainable	
THE RIGHT PEOPLE GRADE OVERALL	The team has a good mix of perspectives and abilities, neither too alike nor too different All team members possess the necessary skills – including teamwork skills—to achieve its purposes
