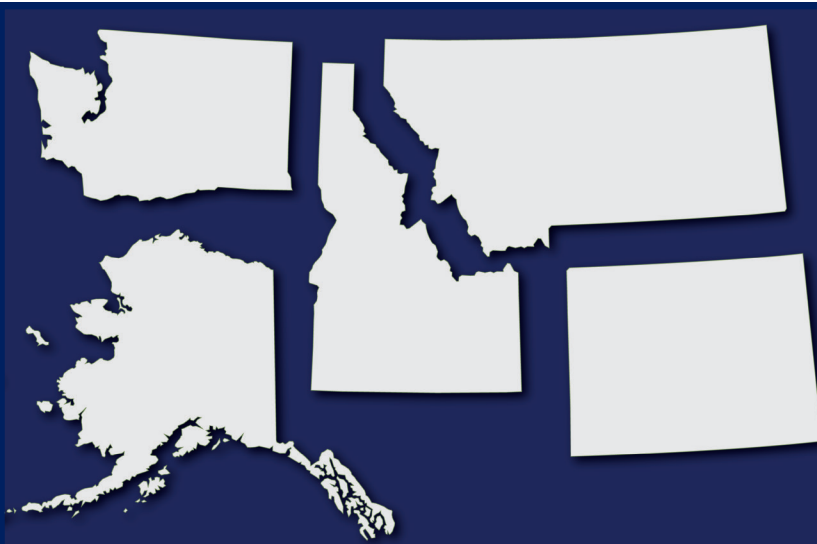


Help Improve Health in Your Local Community
